

JennaRose Venditti, an 8<sup>th</sup> grade student at St. Joseph Catholic School, advanced to the state level during last year's science fair. She was then selected to go to Washington, DC, last Spring

In addition, JennaRose was recently selected to compete nationally in the Broadcom Masters national competition at a society-affiliated science and engineering fair. This nomination is a great honor – only the top 10% of all middle school science projects are selected for this program in the United States.

The project for which Jenna is being nominated is on the hardness of water, and how it affects the world. Semi-finalists will be announced on September 6th, and Jenna will have the opportunity to be selected as a finalist to travel to Washington, DC, in October.

Our dedicated teachers, at St. Joseph Catholic School, were very busy this past summer with many programs, as they prepared to greet our students for a new school year.





- Mrs. Debra Owens, Middle School Math and Social Studies, received a scholarship to attend the National Bearing Witness<sup>™</sup> Summer Institute in Washington, DC.
- Ms. Deborah Suddarth,
  Principal, and Mrs. Juli Ferguson,
  Grade 3 Teacher, received
  scholarships from the University of
  Notre Dame to attend the Latino
  Enrollment Institute. This program was
  created in response to national data
  showing Latinos to be both the fastestgrowing segment of the U.S. Catholic
  Church, and the most under served by
  Catholic schools.
- Mrs. Mara Curran, Grade 5 Teacher, and Ms. Deborah Suddarth, attended the Success Partners Institute.
   Success Partners is grounded in current research that directly correlates student success with parent involvement, and provides the framework for development of a parent-school partnership action plan unique to the school community.
- In May, all teachers at St. Joseph Catholic School received copies of "A Handbook for the Art and Science of Teaching" by Robert Marzano and John L. Brown. This book will be used during the 2016-2017 school year, for a book study program
- In addition, each teacher received online access to Marzano's "Compendium of Teaching Strategies" which includes over 300 teacher classroom plans to improve student learning.
