## 8<sup>th</sup> Grade – History of Passover & Holy Thursday



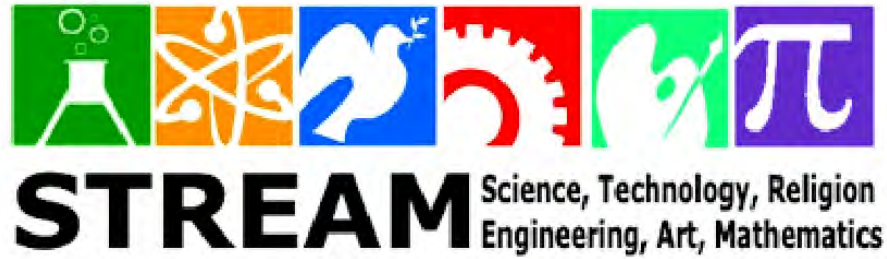
During Holy Week, our eighth grade students explored the traditions of Passover as related to the Christian celebration of the Eucharist and Holy Thursday.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Egg Drop

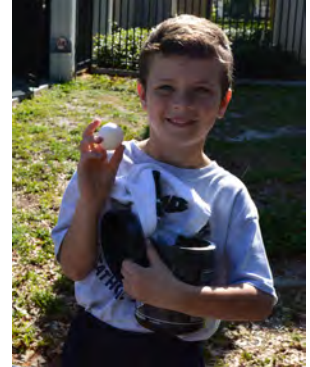
