The Knights of Columbus Soccer Challenge is a competition designed for players to demonstrate the most basic soccer skill – the penalty kick. The competition is open to all boys and girls, ages 9-14, where each player will be allowed 15 shots at the goal from the penalty line (12 yards from the goal). Winners are selected from each age level, and may progress to the district, regional, state and international levels.
