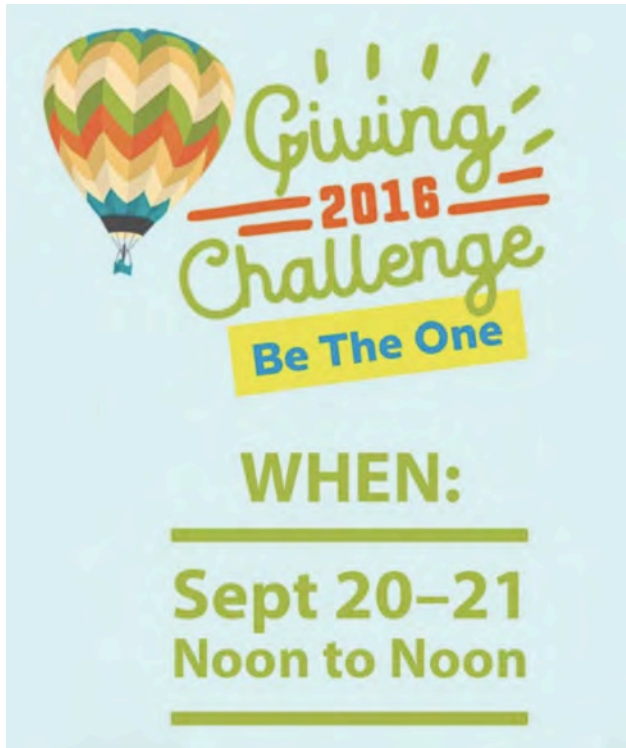
Faith in Action – Mercy Matters
