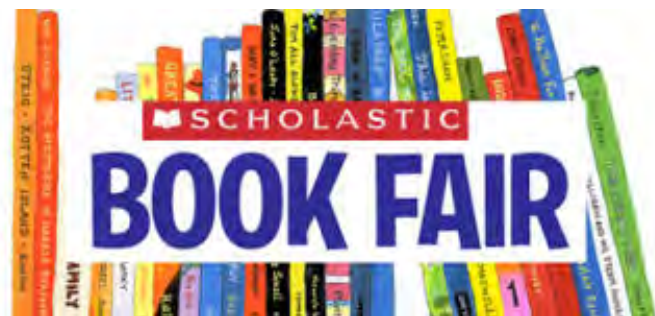
Christmas Cards & Gifts – Arriving this Week
